- 5. **Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Draft Regulation on the Residue Limit for Impurity Heavy Metal Cadmium Contained in Cosmetics and Draft Regulation on the Management of Barium in Cosmetics (2 page(s), in Chinese)
- **6. Description of content:** The Food and Drug Administration, Ministry of Health and Welfare, proposes the following regulations for cosmetics:
 - 1. To lower the maximum level from 20 ppm to 5 ppm for impurity heavy metal Cadmium.
 - 2. To prohibit the use of Barium salts, with the exception of barium sulfate, barium sulphide, and of insoluble barium salts, lakes and pigments prepared from colouring agents.

衛生福利部食品藥物管理署提案訂定化粧品相關規定如下:

1. 不純物重金屬鎘之殘留量最大值從 20 ppm 降到 5 ppm。

2.禁止使用鋇鹽在化妝品中,硫酸鋇、硫化鋇及色素的不溶性鋇鹽(salts)、麗基(lakes)和顏料(pigments)除外。
