Description of content: In response to requests from consumers for further information on shoes, the Department of Commerce require the following information be labelled on shoes: (1) Name of the commodity, (2) Name, telephone number, and address of the manufacturer, or of the importer if applicable, (3) Country of region, (4) Main materials of vamps and soles and (5) Size.		
	The proposed information is required to be labelled on the commodity itself, or sew-on tags, or stick-on tags, or attached cards, or outside packaging. The written language used shall be mainly in Chinese and may be supplemented by foreign languages. Country of region shall be clearly marked on conspicuous places of the commodity itself in Chinese or foreign languages by branding, ironing, printing, or sew-on tags that could not be removed or replaced. Disposable indoor slippers made of paper or fabrics are exempted from the requirements.
