As of 1 July 2009, all such products must be inspected by the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection, and must conform to the safety and EMC inspection requirements when imported or marketed. All the technical requirements for the aforementioned products are CNS standards that have been harmonized with relevant IEC or CISPR standards. This notice also provides the applicable conformity assessment procedures. Two alternative conformity assessment procedures are available to manufacturers and importers at their choice, namely the Registration of Product Certification (RPC) or the Type-approved Batch Inspection (TABI) Scheme.
