**6.** Description of content:

Over the past years, CNS 6532 (Method of test for incombustibility of interior finish material of buildings) has been the only recognized legal testing method for assuring the compliance of the incombustibility of the regulated incombustible interior building materials. The BSMI is planning to recognize CNS 14705, which is primarily based on ISO 5660-1 Rate of heat release from building products (Cone calorimeter test method), as an alternative legal incombustibility testing method starting 1 September 2009. Heat release rate for CNS 14705 is  $8MJ/m^2$ .
