Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Public Notice under the Commodity Inspection Act (2 pages in Chinese, English translation available) 6. Description of content: The Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu intend to regulate Circular sawing machines for wood working, grinding machines and similar equipment as commodities subject to inspection. As of 1 July 2012, all such products must be inspected by the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI), and must conform, where required, to the requirements of the "Safety Standard of Prevention and Guarding Devices - Machinery and Tools" when marketed. The Standard for the aforementioned products where announced by the Council of Labour Affairs on July 27, 1992, and amended on May 13, 2009. The conformity assessment procedure for circular sawing machines for wood working, grinding machines and similar equipment are under the Registration of Product Certification (RPC) Scheme. However, portable circular sawing machines for wood working, and the portable grinding machines and similar equipment are

alternatively subject to the RPC Scheme or Type-approved Batch Inspection Scheme.
