6.	<b>Description of content:</b> The Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI) is very concerned about the safety of erasers, no matter where they might be manufactured. To protect consumer rights and interests, all erasers, whether domestically produced or imported from abroad, must be in compliance with the inspection requirements before they are released from the production premises or the customs. The main measure of revised CNS 6856 increases the requirements with total amount of DEHP, DBP, BBP, DINP, DIDP, DNOP, DMP and DEP in Phthalates less than 0.1% in Article 3.4.
7.	<b>Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Protection of human health and safety
