4.	<b>Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading.</b> <b>ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable):</b> Disposable lighters for igniting tobacco products (CCCN 9613.10.00.00-9, for gas fuelled and non-refillable; CCCN 9613.20.00.00-7, for gas fuelled and refillable; CCCN 9613.80.90.00-5, for other lighters) whose fuel containers are made of resin materials and those use a gas such as butane, isobutene, propane or other liquefied hydrocarbon under pressure as fuel.	
5.	<b>Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:</b> Public Notice under the Commodity Inspection Act (2 pages, in Chinese)	
6.	<b>Description of content:</b> The Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu intends to regulate disposable lighters as commodities subject to inspection. As of 1 August 2004, all such products must be inspected by the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI), and must conform to inspection requirements when imported or marketed within the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu. The technical requirements for the aforementioned lighters are set out in the CNS 10666 that has been harmonized with the international standard ISO 9994:2002 but with child-resistant mechanism added. This Notice also provides the conformity assessment procedures applied.	

- 7. **Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:** At least three serious accidents have been reported to be caused by children misusing disposable lighters during past months this year. Adoption of this mandatory inspection measure is proposed by consumers and would be considered effective to protect consumers and prevent further tragic accidents from happening again.
