Description of content: Aiming to enhance consumer protection, the BSMI proposes to revise the current inspection standards of pressure cookers for domestic use by expanding the scope to cover those with inside volume less than 25 liters (the current scope being less than 10 liters). The conformity assessment procedure for pressure cookers for domestic use subject to this notified measure remains the same, i.e. Registration of Product Certification (RPC) or Batch-by-Batch Inspection (BBI). 為加強消費者保護力度，BSMI 提案修訂家庭用壓力鍋目前的檢測標準，擴大檢測範圍以涵蓋體積小於 25 升的壓力鍋(目前範圍小於 10 升)。 根據本通知措施，家庭用壓力鍋的符合性評鑑程序保持不變，即商品驗證登錄(RPC)或逐批檢驗(BBI)。
