- 5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Proposal for amendment to the legal inspection requirements of lighters (2 page(s), in English; 1 page(s), in Chinese)
- 6. **Description of content:** In order to enhance protection of consumers from hazards arising from unsafe lighters, the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI) proposes to extend the scope of lighters that are currently subject to mandatory inspection. Lighters that have a customs value or ex-factory price less than US\$2.5 (the current scope being less than FOB US\$0.7) will be required to comply with safety requirements specified in CNS 10666. The conformity assessment procedure will remain unchanged, i.e. Type-approve Batch Inspection (TABI).

為了提升保護消費者免受不安全打火機的危害,經濟部標準檢驗局擴大現行強制性檢驗打火機的範圍。每只打火機的起岸完稅價格或出廠價格低於美金 2.5 元者,必須符合 CNS 10666 的安全規範。符合性評鑑方式維持不變,為型式試驗逐批檢驗(TABI)。
