6.	Description of content: The BSMI intends to adopt the revised standard, CNS 11728:2016, of fire-retardant paints for buildings as the inspection standard. New requirements include volatile organic compound (VOC) content, limits of hazardous heavy metals and labelling. The products will be required to comply with the revised standard beginning 1 July 2018. 標準檢驗局將採用建築用防火塗料的修訂標準 CNS 11728:2016 作為檢驗標準。新規定包括揮發性有機化合物(VOC)、有害重金屬含量及標示。產品必須自 107 年 7 月 1 日起符合修正後之標準。
