Directions Governing the Inspection Procedure for Infant Bath Tubs

Adopted and promulgated by Ministerial Order No. 10920005830, BSMI, MOEA on 29 September 2020.

- 1. These Directions are hereby stipulated for implementing the inspection of infant bath tubs.
- 2. Scope of inspection: products for supporting and/or surrounding the infant at the reclining, sitting, or standing positions when being bathed by caretakers; bath tubs, objects with side walls, or similar products which serve for the purpose of containing water and could be placed within an adult bath tubs, a sink, or on top of the surface of other objects.
- 3. Inspection Scheme: Type Approved Batch Inspection <u>or</u> Registration of Product Certification (Module II-Type Test + Module III-Declaration of Conformity to Type).
- 4. Inspection Standards, Inspection Items and Labeling Check Items:
 - (1) Inspection Standards: CNS 16025:2017 Child Use and Care Articles Infant Bath Tubs.
 - (2) Inspection Items:
 - a. Performance Test: Items including "dangerous tips or sharp edges," "openings," "labeling (permanent)," "dead load" and any type having "small objects," "collapse resistance," "shear points, squeeze points and entrapments," "protective components," "binding systems," "suction cup specific requirements" and "toys" shall all be inspected in accordance with the relevant requirements specified in CNS 16025.
 - b. Material Quality (Chemical Property) Test: If any type has surface coating, it is required to submit documents demonstrating compliance with Section 5.3 of CNS 16025 with regard to the lead content in the coating to the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI) of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and its branches (hereinafter referred to as the inspection authority) for review along with the applications for type approval or registration of product certification.
 - c. Chinese Labeling: The text used shall be mainly in traditional Chinese, and the matters and contents labeled shall comply with CNS 16025 and relevant requirements of the Commodity Labeling Act.
 - d. Commodity Inspection Mark: The mark shall be printed by the obligatory inspection applicant who is responsible for inspection application in accordance with the provisions of the "Regulations Governing the Use of Commodity Inspection Mark" and applied in the prominent place of the commodity.
- 5. Relevant Requirements for Type Test:
 - (1) Principles of Type Determination:
 - a. Same Type: Infant bath tubs with the same materials (plastic or non-plastic materials) for the main structure.
 - b. Main Type: Among products of the same type, the one with the most complicated structure shall be regarded as the main type.
 - c. Series of Type: Among products of the same type, those other than the main type shall be regarded as series of type.
 - (2) Locations for Performing Type Test: Designated testing laboratories of the BSMI.
 - (3) Type Test Items: For each product of the main type, items including "dangerous tips or sharp edges," "openings," "labeling (permanent)," "dead load" and any type having "small objects," "collapse resistance," "shear points, squeeze points and entrapments,"

"protective components," "binding systems," "suction cup specific requirements" and "toys" shall all be tested in acccordance with relevant requirements specified in CNS 16025. For series of type, the test is only required for parts different from the main type.

- (4) The obligatory inspection applicant applying for type test shall submit the following documents in triplicate as well as the samples to the designated testing laboratories for performing the test:
 - a. Type classification table.
 - b. Color photos of the infant bath tubs (electronic files of 4x6 inch or larger-sized photos showing the front, rear and side views of the product).
 - c. Documents demonstrating compliance with Section 5.3 of CNS 16025 with regard to the lead content in the coating.
 - d. Samples of the Chinese labels.
 - e. User's manual.
 - f. Product information.
 - g. Samples: For each infant bath tub of the main type and series of the type, one sample shall be respectively submitted. However, the designated testing laboratories may request additional test samples if necessary.
 - h. Type Test Fees: The fees shall be collected in accordance with the Regulations Governing Fees for Commodity Inspection or the fee schedule specified by the designated testing laboratories.
- 6. Article 6 Relevant Regulations Regarding Type Approved Batch Inspection:
 - (1) The obligatory inspection applicant shall first obtain the type approval certificate and make applications to the inspection authority for inspection before their products are shipped out of the production premises or imported. When applying for inspection, the month and year of manufacture shall be filled in, and the Commodity Inspection Mark shall be printed on the applicant's own responsibility. The Commodity Inspection Mark consists of a disgram and an identification number (including the Roman letter "T" and a designated code). The identification number shall be right below or proximately to the right side of the diagram.

Example:



T means Type Approved Batch Inspection

00000 shall be the code designated by the inspection authority to the applicant

- (2) The obligatory inspection applicant applying for type approval shall submit to the inspection authority the type test report, the required documents specified in Clause 5.4, and the required documents specified in Subparagraph 1, Paragraph 1, Article 5 of the Regulations Governing Type Approval of Commodities.
- (3) The Review Period of Type Approval: 14 working days from the receipt of the application by the inspection authority (not including the time for delivery of additional materials or samples). Where additional samples are drawn, such period shall be extended to another 14 working days after the receipt of the samples.
- (4) Applicantions for the same batch of infant bath tubs shall be of the same type and of the

same obligatory inspection applicant.

- (5) The inspection authority shall confirm that the infant bath tubs submitted for inspection are listed in the Type Approval Certificate. 20% of the applications will be randomly sampled for inspection and the other 80% are processed by document review. For the 20% sampled applications, one-third of the items listed in the same application shall be randomly selected for drawing samples (the number of items less than three shall be counted as three; a minimum of one item and a maximum of five items shall be selected). For each selected item, one piece of the products under that item shall be randomly sampled for testing, checked for the Chinese labeling and the Commodity Inspection Mark. The quantity of selected items and sampled pieces shall be increased if necessary.
- (6) The inspection authority shall perform one to two of the following test items based on the risk level: "shear points, squeeze points and entrapments," "openings," "protective components" and "dead load."
- (7) Inspection Period: 5 working days after the samples are delivered to the designated testing laboratory.
- (8) The inspection authority shall issue a notice of nonconformity for commodities that do not comply with the requirements. The obligatory inspection applicant may apply for re-inspection without any charge within 15 days after receiving such notice. Products that comply with the requirements may be released separately. Products that do not comply with the requirements shall be processed in accordance with the Regulations Governing Disposition of Commodities Failing Inspectionas specified below.
 - a. Where the non-compliant products are to be returned for the whole batch, the obligatory inspection applicant shall report to the inspection authority and provide re-export documents issued by the Customs within 3 months after the products are returned in order to close the case.
 - b. Where the non-compliant products are to be destroyed for the whole batch, the obligatory inspection applicant shall apply to the inspection authority by presenting the destruction plan in order to close the case.
 - c. Where the non-compliant products are subject to correction under surveillance or part of the batch are to be destroyed/returned, the obligatory inspection applicant shall present the approval letter from the inspection authority, notice of nonconformity, import declaration (not applicable for domestically-manufactured products), and documents verifying the correction when submitting a new application for inspection (covering items not previously sampled) to the inspection authority.
 - d. Where a new application was made, the sampling rate of items for inspection shall be doubled, which shall include the non-compliant items after correction. Non-compliant products, as well as items not sampled, of the new application shall be destroyed or returned and compliant products may be released separately.
- (9) Where the products sampled are found not in compliance with the inspection requiremens, subsequent infant bath tubs from the same obligatory inspection applicant shall be inspected by batch. The sampling rate will be resumed to 20% after compliance of 3 consecutive batches.
- (10) For those items that have not been sampled, the inspection authority performing the inspection shall adopt the approach of document review to compare the types of products submitted for inspection based on the relevant information in the application.
- (11) If there are changes in the scope of the products listed in the type approval certificate (e.g. changes to the main type or series of type, inspection standards or inspection items), the applicant shall obtain a new type test report from the original report issuance testing

laboratory and apply to the inspection authority for a replaced certificate.

- 7. Relevant Requirements for Registration of Product Certification (RPC):
 - (1) The obligatory inspection applicant shall obtain the RPC certificate before their products are shipped out of the production proemises or imported.
 - (2) To apply for an RPC certificate, the applicant shall apply to the inspection authority and provide the type test report in accordance with Clause 5, the required documents specified in Subparagraph 1, Paragraph 1, Article 4 of the Regulations Governing Registration of Product Certification, the conformity assessment document (the Declaration of Conformity to Type) and the documents specified in Clause 5.4.
 - (3) The Review Period of RPC: 14 working days from the receipt of the application by the inspection authority (not including the time for delivery of additional materials or samples). Where additional samples are drawn, such period shall be extended to another 14 working days after the receipt of the samples.
 - (4) Applicants granted RPC certificates shall print the Commodity Inspection Mark on their

own responsibility. The Commidity Inspection Mark consists of a diagram \bigcirc and an identification number (a Roman letter "R" and a designated code). The identification number shall be right below or proximately to the right side of the diagram.

R means Registration of Product Certification

00000 shall be the code designated by the inspection authority to the applicant

(5) If there are changes in the scope of the products listed in the RPC certificate (e.g. changes to main type or series of type, inspection standards or inspected items), the applicant shall obtain a new type test report from the original report issuance laboratory and apply to the inspection authority for a replaced certificate renewal.
