Description: The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) is finalizing an extension to the compliance dates applicable to certain entities subject to the regulation of methylene chloride promulgated under the Toxic Substances Control Act ([TSCA](#)). Specifically, EPA is finalizing an 18-month extension of the Workplace Chemical Protection Program ([WCPP](#)) and associated recordkeeping compliance dates for industrial or commercial laboratories that are not owned or operated by Federal agencies or contractors acting on behalf of the Federal government. Under this final rule, all non-Federal laboratories will share the same compliance dates with Federal and Federally contracted laboratories. EPA is finalizing an extension of the compliance dates for associated laboratory activities detailed in this final rule to avoid disruption of important functions of non-Federal laboratories such as the use of environmental monitoring methods needed for cleanup

sites and wastewater treatment, as well as activities associated with university laboratories or law enforcement laboratories.

This final rule is effective on 15 December 2025.

美國環境保護署（EPA，以下稱「本署」）正在最終敲定延長部分受《有毒物質管制法》（TSCA）規範之機構，在使用氯甲烷時所適用的合規期限。具體而言，本署將為不屬於聯邦機構所有或營運、亦非代表聯邦政府之承包商運作的工業或商業實驗室，提供「工作場所化學品保護計畫」（WCPP）及相關紀錄保存要求的 18 個月期限延長。依據本最終規則，所有非聯邦實驗室將與聯邦及聯邦承包實驗室採用相同的合規期限。

EPA 推動此項期限延長，是為避免非聯邦實驗室在執行重要職能時受到干擾。這些重要職能包括：用於污染整治場址及廢水處理所需的环境監測方法，以及大學實驗室與執法實驗室所進行的相關工作。

本最終規則將於 2025 年 12 月 15 日生效。

Description of content: Proposed rule - The Environmental Protection Agency is proposing changes to regulations promulgated under the Technology Transitions section of the American Innovation and Manufacturing Act of 2020 , which authorizes the Administrator to restrict the use of particular hydrofluorocarbons in the sectors and subsectors in which they are used. This proposal addresses administrative petitions and other requests from companies and trade associations across a number of subsectors, including refrigerated transport--intermodal containers, industrial process refrigeration and chillers for industrial process refrigeration used in semiconductor manufacturing, retail food refrigeration systems for remote condensing units and supermarkets, cold storage warehouses, refrigerated laboratory centrifuges, laboratory shakers, and condensing units in residential and light commercial air conditioning and heat pumps. This action proposes to allow previously manufactured and imported residential and light commercial air conditioning and heat pump equipment to continue to be installed. The Agency is also seeking advance comment on potential actions to address supply chain issues for a refrigerant blend.

美國環境保護署（EPA）正提議更新依據《2020年美國創新與製造法案》之「技術轉型」章節所發布的相關法規。該法案授權署長對特定的氫氟碳化物（HFC）在各行業及其子領域中的使用進行限制。

此項提案回應來自多個子領域的企業與行業協會所提交的行政請願與相關請求，涵蓋範圍包括：冷藏運輸（例如：國際多式聯運集裝箱）、工業流程製冷與半導體製造所使用的冷水機、遠端冷凝機組及超市使用的零售食品冷藏系統、低溫倉儲、冷凍式實驗室離心機、實驗室振盪器，以及住宅與輕型商用空調與熱泵系統中的冷凝機組。

該提案將允許先前已生產與進口的住宅與輕型商用空調及熱泵設備繼續安裝。EPA也正在徵求初步意見，以協助評估可能採取的措施，來因應特定冷媒混合物的供應鏈問題。

Description: The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) is extending the postponement of the effectiveness of certain regulatory provisions of the [final rule](#) entitled "Trichloroethylene (TCE); Regulation Under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)" (notified as [G/TBT/N/USA/2062/Add.1](#)) for an additional 90 days. Specifically, this postponement applies to the conditions imposed on the uses with TSCA section 6(g) exemptions.

As of 17 November 2025, EPA further postpones until 17 February 2026, the conditions imposed on each of the TSCA section 6(g) exemptions, as described in this document, in the final rule published on 17 December 2024, at [89 FR 102568](#).

Description of content: Proposed rule - The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) is proposing amendments to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regulation for reporting and recordkeeping requirements for perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). As promulgated in October 2023 (final rule notified as G/TBT/N/USA/1742/Add.3), the regulation requires manufacturers (including importers) of PFAS in any year between 2011-2022 to report certain data to EPA related to exposure and environmental and health effects. EPA is proposing to incorporate certain exemptions and other modifications to the scope of the reporting regulation. These exemptions would maintain important reporting on PFAS, consistent with statutory requirements, while exempting reporting on activities about which manufacturers are least likely to know or reasonably ascertain.

This action would amend the SNURs to (1) allow certain new uses reported in the SNUNs or PMNs without additional notification requirements, (2) modify the significant new use notification requirements based on the actions and determinations for the SNUN or PMN submissions or based on the examination of new test data or other information, and (3) make technical amendments to several SNURs. The SNURs require persons who intend to manufacture (defined by statute to include import) or process any of these chemical substances for an activity that is proposed as a significant new use by this rulemaking to notify EPA at least 90 days before commencing that activity. The required notification initiates EPA's evaluation of the conditions of that use for that chemical substance.
