5.	Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Public Notice under the Commodity Inspection Act (Nine pages in Chinese)
6.	Description of content: The TPKM intends to regulate the electronic consumer products of HDTV, LCD TV, Plasma TV, VCD players, DVD players, Digital cameras and Digital Video cameras as commodities subject to inspection. As of 1 January 2005, all such products must be inspected by the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection, and must conform to the safety and EMC inspection requirements (except that the digital cameras and digital video cameras are required to comply with EMC requirements only) when imported or marketed. All the technical requirements for the aforementioned products are CNS standards that have been harmonized with relevant IEC or CISPR standards. This notice also provides the applicable conformity assessment procedures. The digital cameras and digital video cameras will be subject to Declaration of Conformity scheme, while others will be subject to a dual-track approach to conformity assessment procedures, namely Registration of Product Certification or Type-approved Batch Inspection.
